

Information on Asia Pacific Chambers Congress (APCC)

In order to strengthen close links and cooperation among Asia Pacific business community, promote economic recovery in the Asia Pacific region, discuss economic and trade issues in the Asia Pacific region, and advance regional economic and trade cooperation, China Chamber of International Commerce (CCOIC) and Jiangsu Provincial Government will host the first Asia Pacific Chambers Congress (APCC) in Kunshan, Jiangsu Province, China from 29th March 2012 to the morning of 30th March 2012.

The first APCC, as an integral part of China International Import Expo (CIE 2012), is designed for facilitating the successful conclusion of CIE 2012 and providing an effective platform for chambers of commerce and business associations in the Asia Pacific region to cooperate and exchange ideas. With the theme of *Exports to China*, it will invite representatives from chambers of commerce, business associations and renowned enterprises as speakers to mainly discuss the impact of China's import expansion on economies in the Asia Pacific region and economic recovery and trade outlook in this region. The APCC has got the support of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) and World Chambers Federation (WCF). Approximately 300 delegates will be expected to attend this event. Its delegates will be government officials, trade experts, and representatives from chambers of commerce, business associations,

enterprises and others.
